Scholarship Opportunities

Academic Scholarship

A successful candidate for the Academic Scholarship will have proven success up to and including Year 4 in a minimum of two key learning areas. English and/or Mathematics should be featured in the skill set. The successful candidate will contribute to the academic life of the school and will be selected after sitting an independent assessment and completing an interview with the Head of School. Scholarships include a reduction in tuition fees by varying percentages and are available for students in Year 5, 2018. The scholarship is for a two year period encompassing Year 5 and 6.

Music Scholarship

A successful candidate for the Music Scholarship will receive band tuition and membership for up to two instruments (concert band/strings) and access to our music programme and an adjusted timetable, where required, to support their learning and contribution to Music. Musical progress is essential and there is an expectation to contribute to the co-curricular life of the school. Following an independent assessment, interview with the Head of School and performance opportunity, scholarships including a reduction in tuition fees by varying percentages will be offered. The scholarship is for a two year period encompassing Year 5 and 6.

Sport Scholarship

A successful candidate for the Sport Scholarship will receive specialised coaching in tennis and/ or football through our Football Development League and Tennis Coaching opportunities. Progress will be monitored with opportunity to represent the school in many sporting areas. Successful candidates will have proven capacity in a combination of more than one sporting area and should include at least one of Swimming, Athletics or Cross Country. Following an independent assessment, interview with the Head of School, scholarships including a reduction in tuition fees by varying percentages will be offered. The scholarship is for a two year period encompassing Year 5 and 6.

The School may elect to offer Partial Scholarships and Encouragement Scholarships at its absolute discretion.



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Application for Scholarship

Applications for Scholarships should be made by completing the Scholarship Application Form which is available from the school website. Categories for Scholarships include Academic, Music and Sport.

Payment for the Scholarship should be submitted when lodging your application.
